

Rally and Obedience Rules and Ring Awareness Seminar

Purpose

To learn myths vs truths about the obedience and rally rules, to avoid losing points unnecessarily, to increase your performance and confidence in the ring through better understanding, to ask senior judges any questions you may have about rules and ring procedures, to be sure you are providing the most accurate and helpful information to handlers you are coaching.

Who should attend

Current triallers, intending triallers, those who coach triallers in any level of obedience or rally obedience.

Format

Initial session on rules and ring issues relevant to both rally and obedience, followed by your choice of break-out groups on rally, CCD, CD, CDX, UD, and UDX. Each break-out group will begin with one or more senior judges discussing common misunderstandings about rules and procedures resulting in handler errors at that level, followed by question and answer opportunities. Each break-out group will be repeated up to three times, allowing participants to move to from one group to another to learn tips specific to different disciplines/levels as the evening progresses (or stay in the same group if preferred). The panel of judges includes Val Bonney, Warren Doyle, Georgina Golle, Cyn D. Fisher, Lawrie Knauth, Chris Pain, Coral Pethers, Laura Schimke, Des Strong, and Tabitha Young.
